Story Classes



Wee Read (birth to 18 mos with adult):

A program for babies and caregivers which includes tips, board books, songs, and finger-plays to help your baby learn to love books. Please make other arrangements for siblings so this is a special time for you and your baby.

Mondays 10 –10:30 Starting January 24th running for 6 weeks.

Toddletime(18 to 36 mos with adult)

A program for tots and caregivers to help introduce toddlers to the world of books through stories, finger-plays and songs. Social playtime will be distanced this time. Please make other arrangements for siblings so this is a special time for you and your toddler.

Tuesdays 9:30– 10:15 or 10:30-11:15 or Wednesdays 9:30–10:15 Starting January 25th or 26th running for 6 weeks

Circletime (3 years old):

This program for 3 year olds is a chance for the child to be on his own without Mom or Dad. It will include stories, songs, finger-plays and crafts in a small group atmosphere.

Mondays 11-11:30am Starting January 24th running for 8 weeks

Preschool Story Hour (4 or 5 year olds not in kindergarten):

A program of stories, songs, and crafts based on a theme. Bring your library card so your child can choose books!

Thursdays 10:30-11:15 or 1:30-2:15pm Starting January 27th running for 8 weeks

Tuesday Blue Witch Book Club (Gr.3-6)

Based on the “Legends of Orkney” series, students at the Tarkana Witch Academy will meet each week for spellbinding activities and assignments! Each week there will be new chapters to listen to for class.

Tuesdays 6:00-7:00pm Starting January 25th running for 8 weeks

Mixed Media Wednesday (Gr. K-2)

Children must be the age specified by the first session of the program

Programs are open to Goshen residents first. If the program is not filled, non-Goshen library patrons may attend. Please check with the Just for Kids staff for more information.

Also please remember that if you are unable to make a program you have registered for, please let us know. There may be a waiting list.

If you are on a waiting list, the library will call you if a space becomes available. Sadly, we can not always allow children who come on the day of the program and are not on the registration list to participate especially if there are limited supplies.

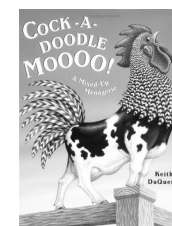


Kids’ Read and Create for Gr. K-2
