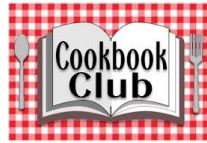

Thursday, Feb. 21st @ 6:30 pm.

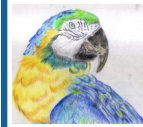
