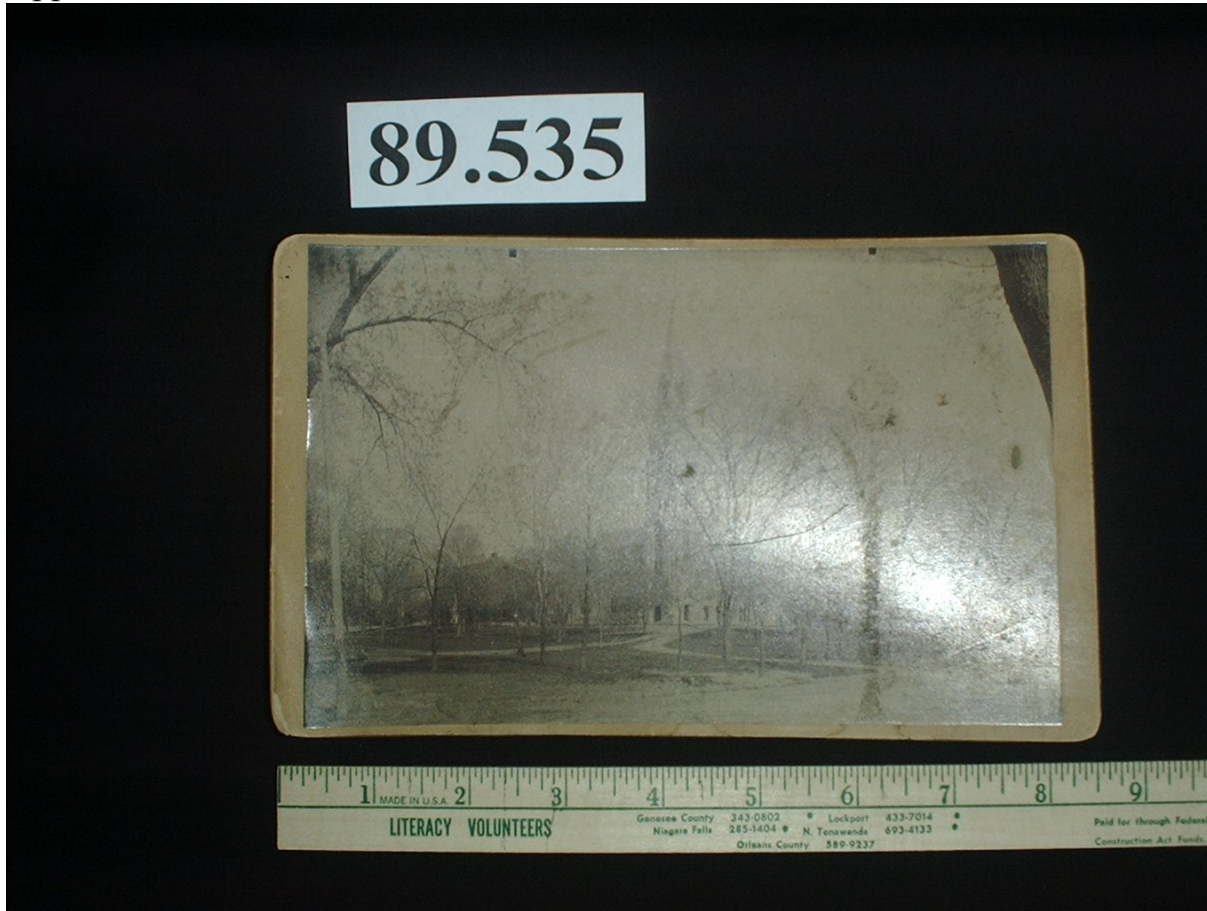

This Indenture

Made the 10th day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy between The Trustees of the First Presbyterian Church, in Graham, in the County of Orange, of the first part, and the Trustees of the Presbyterian Church, in Graham, in the County of Orange, of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars and no Cents, to the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars and no Cents, to the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, all that certain PEW in the New Stone Church, in the Town aforesaid, belonging to the parties of the first part, numbered Thirty-two together with the appurtenances to the same belonging, with all the right both in law and equity, which the said parties of the first part have, or in or to the same. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever. Upon this express CONDITION however, That the said parties of the second part, their heirs or assigns, do pay or cause to be paid, to the said parties of the first part, or their successors in office, the yearly salary which now is or hereafter may be duly assessed on the said Pew, to be paid quarter yearly every year, for the purpose of supporting the stated preaching of the Gospel in said Church, according to the rules and regulations of the Presbyterian Church under the care of the General Assembly of Presbyterians in the United States. And the said parties of the second part for their heirs and assigns, doth covenant and agree with the said parties of the first part and their successors, that upon the non-payment of the quarter yearly salary aforesaid, when the same shall become due, that then and in such case it shall be lawful for the said parties of the first part or their successors, to enter into the property and take possession of the said Pew, numbered Thirty-two and rent the same for the purpose of paying the salary assessed on the same as aforesaid, until the said parties of the second part, their heirs or assigns, shall pay or cause to be paid unto the said parties of the first part or their successors, all salary in arrears on said Pew.

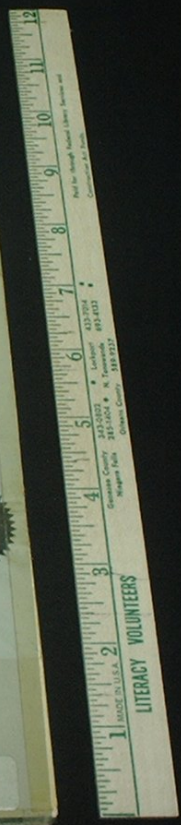
