Glass paperweight with photos of the first high school in Goshen	89.600	Between 1891 and 1912	This photograph in this paperweight is of Goshen High School prior to the Yellow Brick Building, which was completed in 1912. This building was situated between the Main Street building and Webster Avenue.	Appendix Item A600
The Elementary Spelling Book, Revised Edition	89.616	1860	This Webster Blue Back Speller was not his first. This was published in 1860 rather than the late 1700s.	N/A
