Bronze star with other award ribbons	89.599	1946	Wallace C. Douglass (1907-1972) from Goshen, New York, enlisted in the U.S. Army in February 1942. He became a Staff Sergeant and was awarded the Bronze Star for bravery in action in May 1946.	Appendix Item A599
Two World War II Armbands	89.623 a, b	World War II, 1941-1946	Item a: White Band, Blue Circle, White Triangle within and Red Lightning. Item b: Purple arm band, with the words "U.S. Army Air Force, AWS, Observer." Goshen's WWII Airfract Observer Post was located in a roof-top room of the barn which stood on the former (Senator) McCarthy property (Parkway Farm) to the rear of the Historic Track.
