Stretch Your Vacation & Staycation Dollars!

Stretch your vacation and staycation dollars with the help of the Goshen Public Library & Historical Society's Museum Pass Program. Goshen Public Library cardholders may borrow free and discounted access passes to ten different local and not-so-local museums and attractions. What a great reason to stop in the Library and get (or renew) your library card!

The Library's Museum Pass Program is perfect to use for family outings and mini-get-aways! Taking in NYC for a family weekend? The Library has passes (single and group) for the Guggenheim Museum and the Intrepid Sea, Air & Space Museum. The Library also sells single-admission tickets for \$10 to the American Museum of Natural History, perfect for your visiting with out-of-state friends and family.

Looking for something a little closer to home, the Museum Program offers free admission to the Hudson River Maritime Museum (Kingston), the Museum at Bethel Woods (Bethel), Museum Village (Monroe), and FDR Library and Museum (Hyde Park). Or enjoy some outdoor time with passes to the Storm King Art Center (New Windsor), the Boscobel House & Gardens (Garrison), or the Mohonk Reserve (New Paltz). All of these are also wonderful opportunities for new residents to learn more about the area.

Each individual museum has different guidelines for using the passes and varying hours of operation. Call the Library to confirm availability of a pass and to get all the details on how to use a pass.
